FEAST OF ST. BLAISE, **February 3rd**.

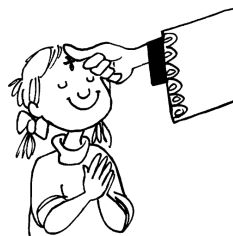
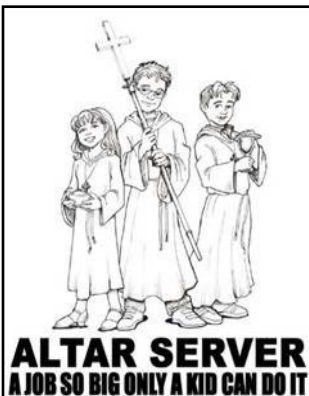
