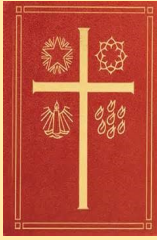

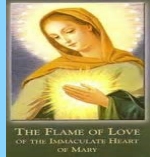

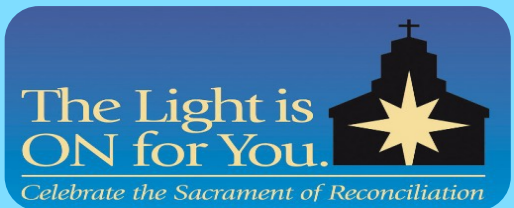

If you or a loved one is homebound and would like to receive the Most Blessed Sacrament, please call the Rectory Office.



I am asking all our parishioners to take the following precautions to help mitigate the effects of the influenza (flu).

Parishioners are asked not to shake hands with the Priest, Deacons, Altar Servers and Eucharistic Ministers before/after Mass.

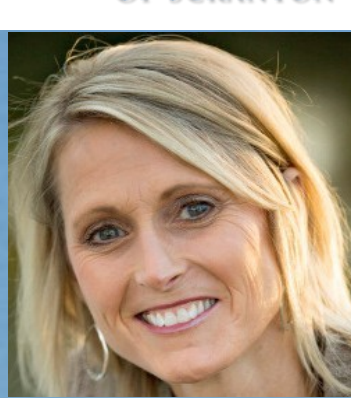

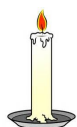

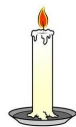
