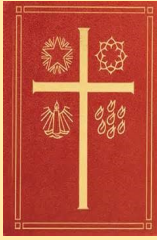

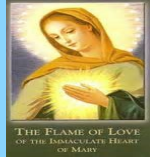

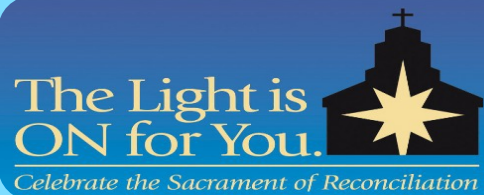
We pray the Rosary, accompanied by scripture readings, music [psalms & songs] and Decade prayers.
